TITLE 15. MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC

CHAPTER 15-300. ALCOHOL - INCOMPETENTS

15-301. Permitting Use by One under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any vehicle or any person having charge of any vehicle to permit the same to be driven or operated on any street in this City by any person who is under the influence of alcohol or any drug or combination of alcohol and any drug.

15-302. Intoxicated Person in or about a Vehicle. It shall be unlawful for any person under the influence of alcohol or any drug or combination of alcohol and any drug to be in or about any vehicle with the intention of driving or operating such vehicle.

15-303. Permitting Incapable Driver to Drive Prohibited.

- (1) No owner or person having control of a vehicle shall knowingly permit said vehicle to be operated by any person who is physically or mentally disabled to such an extent that such person's judgement or driving ability is impaired.
- (2) No owner or person having charge or control of any motor vehicle shall require or knowingly permit any prohibited person, as set forth in Section 15-601, to drive the same or knowingly permit or require the operation of any vehicle in any manner contrary to law.

15-304. Incapable Drivers - Incompetent Drivers.

No person physically or mentally disabled or incapacitated in any particular, temporary, or permanent manner, shall drive a motor vehicle upon any street or alley, provided such disability or incapacity is such as to interfere with the reasonable and safe operation of such vehicle.
