TITLE 15. MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC

CHAPTER15-400. TURNS

15-401. Turning Around.

- (1) The operator of any vehicle may not turn the vehicle to proceed in the opposite direction unless the movement can be made safely and without interfering with other traffic.
- (2) A vehicle may not be turned to proceed in the opposite direction on any curve, or upon the approach to, or near the crest of a grade, if the vehicle is not visible at a distance of five hundred feet (500') by the operator of any other vehicle approaching from either direction.
- (3) No person shall make a U-turn within one block, either North or South, of Main Street, between the railroad tracks on West Main Street and the Malad River Bridge on East Main Street.
- **15-402. Starting Vehicles.** No person shall start a vehicle which is stopped, standing, or parked unless such movement can be made with reasonable safety nor move such vehicle without first giving the appropriate signal.
