CHAPTER 15-400. TURNS

15-401. Turning Around.

(1) The operator of any vehicle may not turn the vehicle to proceed in the opposite direction unless the movement can be made safely and without interfering with other traffic.

(2) A vehicle may not be turned to proceed in the opposite direction on any curve, or upon the approach to, or near the crest of a grade, if the vehicle is not visible at a distance of five hundred feet (500') by the operator of any other vehicle approaching from either direction.

(3) No person shall make a U-turn within one block, either North or South, of Main Street, between the railroad tracks on West Main Street and the Malad River Bridge on East Main Street.

15-402. Starting Vehicles. No person shall start a vehicle which is stopped, standing, or parked unless such movement can be made with reasonable safety nor move such vehicle without first giving the appropriate signal.
