TITLE 8. CITY PROPERTY.

CHAPTER 8-1000. VIEWING A PARADE OR SPECIAL EVENT.

8-1001. Items or Objects on Public Property. It shall be unlawful for any person to attempt to claim, reserve or occupy, either in person or by the placement of any object or item (which may include but is not limited to ropes, tents, chairs, sleeping bags, blankets, or other devises or barriers, on any public property) a location for viewing and observing a parade or special event before 6 a.m., on the day of the parade or special event. Any object or item placed before the aforementioned date and time or placed after the aforementioned date and time that is determined to be a hazard, or to negatively impact, or damage public property by any City Official, is subject to being immediately removed from public property and discarded by any City Official. All objects or items which are legally placed shall be immediately removed by the person that placed the item on public property immediately following the parade or special event.

8-1002. Occupation of Public Property by a **Person.** This Ordinance shall not be misconstrued to mean that the placement of any object or item on public property in advance of a parade or special event actually reserves that specific location for a person or individual to view or observe the parade or special event. Locations for viewing and observing a parade and special events on public property are claimed and reserved only by a person being continuously present and occupying the public property until and throughout the parade or special event. However, it shall be unlawful for any person or individual to continuously be present and occupy a location or position for viewing or observing a parade or special event on public property before 6 a.m., on the day of the parade or special event.
